

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL BOARD OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR
THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSVILLE
June 12, 2013**

Purpose of this Special Board Meeting was to discuss the Birch Lane/Evergreen Court project. The sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and street will all be replaced.

Village Engineer, Kevin Kuhn from Kuhn & Trello presented plans for this project. He thanked everyone who had a basement for letting him do the inspections. The inspections resulted in the findings of not being able to reverse the sewer direction. So, all sewer lines will be replaced exactly the same and will still be routed to the lift station.

This project will take approximately 180 work days (9 months) to complete. There is a possibility this project will be started in October. This project will be an inconvenience, but worth it in the end. Every driveway will be open in the evenings. Birch Lane will never be entirely closed, at least one entrance will always remain open.

The Village has received a grant for a large portion of the sanitary sewer portion. The Village is looking into funding for the additional expense of the sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and street. The project will be funded by bonding or a loan.

Some driveways will have to be replaced. Residents may inspect the plans located at the Village Hall to see how their residence will be affected. The driveway will be replaced with the exact type of material that it currently is.

The question was raised if this project will raise property taxes? The answer is no. The only project that will increase property taxes is the new library/museum.

If anyone would like to see the project plans and the exhibits prepared by the Engineer, feel free to do so at the Village Hall.
