

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR  
THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSVILLE  
August 9, 2021**

The Town Hall/board meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by President Yokley. Clerk: Karen Winger.  
Trustees Present: Gettleman, Carter, Bunger, Hofferkamp, Tierney, Brennan.

**COMMUNICATIONS:** President Yokley stated there are a couple residents who are dealing with a property that is not maintained. He stated that if you are guilty of not maintaining your property, you need to clean it up immediately.

Trustee Carter made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on July 26, 2021. Trustee Gettleman seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**FINANCE (Tierney):** Trustee Tierney made a motion to pay bills as presented. Trustee Hofferkamp seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

**PUBLIC SAFETY (John Brennan):** Trustee Brennan discussed a company called Lexipol. This is a risk management organization who deals with Police Departments. This company compiles all the legal aspects into our policies and maintains them. A Public Safety committee meeting was held to discuss. Trustee Brennan and Chief Edwards have some questions to ask Lexipol before starting a membership.

Trustee Brennan stated Officer Harmon has submitted his resignation. He will be working for Secretary of State Police Department. Officer Harmon's last day with the Village will be August 25<sup>th</sup>. The Williamsville Police Department will have a job opening in the future.

**WATER & SEWER (Matt Bunger):** Trustee Bunger discussed the issue with sump pumps illegally draining into our sanitary sewer system and overloading the system. A letter has been drafted to residents regarding this issue. Roy Pyers shared a pamphlet he has regarding sump pump drainage. Trustee Bunger would like for the Village to create a similar brochure for residents.

Also discussed was a water main break that happened earlier in the day on West Harpole. This break happened on the same stretch as the last break. President Yokley stated this section of water line will need to be replaced quickly. Kent Thompson will be gathering estimates for an emergency water line replacement.

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (Hofferkamp):** Trustee Hofferkamp stated she will ask the Community Foundation for a donation to the Sherman Area Chamber.

Trustee Hofferkamp stated her committee will be looking at a possible TIF application.

**PARKS & RECREATION (Dave Carter):** Trustee Carter had nothing new to report.

**STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS & STORM SEWERS (Patrick Gettleman):** Trustee Gettleman had nothing new to report. Oil/chipping of the streets has been moved back a week, per Craig Winger.

**ADDITIONAL BUSINESS:** Trustee Tierney made a motion to approve Trick-or-Treating on October 31<sup>st</sup> from 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. Trustee Brennan seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

Roy Pyers discussed the events scheduled for the upcoming Fall Festival. The board will have to approve some road closures next board meeting.

The regular board meeting of the Board of Trustees for the Village of Williamsville adjourned at 6:46 p.m.
