

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR  
THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSVILLE  
July 12, 2021**

The Town Hall/board meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by President Yokley. Clerk: Karen Winger.  
Trustees Present: Gettleman, Carter, Bunger, Brennan, Hofferkamp, Absent: Tierney

**GUESTS:** See attached.

Joe & Rebecca Dombrowski attended the meeting to discuss notifications for Village residents. They were concerned after an incident happened by their residence and no notifications were released to residents. President Yokley said the Village will look into ways to improve the communication in the future.

Roy Pyers attended the meeting to discuss an event scheduled for Sunday, July 25<sup>th</sup> from 10-2:00 at the Interurban Merchant. He stated there will be vendors set up in the street selling local products. He has asked that Main Street between Walnut and Pine Street be closed for a few hours that day. He stated they have approximately 7-10 vendors scheduled to be there. Bella Trattoria will be selling pizza by the slice during the event.

**COMMUNICATIONS:** President Yokley stated the Village is aware of the water/sewer situation. He stated Public Works Department is doing their best. He stated we have received an abundance amount of rain and we can't beat mother-nature. He stated that it is a violation of law to have your sump pump hooked into the sanitary sewer system. He stated that if you are aware that your sump pump hooks into the sewer system, you need to disconnect immediately. He stated the Village has put out numerous warnings over the years. He stated these situations are hard to identify since it is a closed system.

Trustee Brennan made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on June 28, 2021. Trustee Carter seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**FINANCE (Tierney):** Trustee Tierney was absent. Trustee Hofferkamp made a motion to pay bills as presented. Trustee Brennan seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

**PUBLIC SAFETY (John Brennan):** Trustee Brennan stated the Village will look at ways to improve the communication system.

Trustee Brennan stated there will be meeting held soon with Lexipol. Lexipol is a company that compiles the Police Department's information and makes sure they are in compliance with the laws/regulations.

**WATER & SEWER (Matt Bunger):** Trustee Bunger made a motion to approve the sewer project bid from Leander Construction Inc. in the amount of \$1,343,000.00. Trustee Carter seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

Kevin Kuhn stated they have looked into ways of saving some money for this sewer project, but no such luck. A start date for this project has not been set yet.

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (Hofferkamp):** Trustee Hofferkamp had nothing new to report.

**PARKS & RECREATION (Dave Carter):** Trustee Carter thanked Public Works for their great work.

**STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS & STORM SEWERS (Patrick Gettleman):** Phil Koeberlein is concerned about a drainage problem near the park. Kent Thompson stated he will keep it in mind, however; it is not top priority at this time due to more pressing projects. He stated they will look at this project in the fall.

The project on Ann Rutledge has started. They are removing the curb and fixing the drainage problem. Oil/chipping is scheduled for the first week of August.

President Yokley asked Trustee Gettleman to work with Roy Pyers regarding the sidewalk in front of his house.

**ADDITIONAL BUSINESS:** Trustee Hofferkamp made a motion to approve road closure on Main Street from Walnut to Pine Street on July 25<sup>th</sup> for four hours. Trustee Gettleman seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

Trustee Carter made an amendment to the street closure motion, stating the road will be closed from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Trustee Brennan seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

A tractor show will be part of the Fall Festival this year. There are approximately thirty entries for the tractor show so far.

Tickets are still available for the Dueling Piano event to be held on Sunday, September 12<sup>th</sup>. You can also purchase an entire table for the event.

The regular board meeting of the Board of Trustees for the Village of Williamsville adjourned at 6:54 p.m.
