**COMMUNICATIONS:** No communications to report.

Trustee Tierney made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on March 25, 2024.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:** Michelle Knox, from WindSolar USA, attended the meeting to discuss a proposed solar project at the sewer plant.
