

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR
THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSVILLE
August 12, 2024**

The Town Hall/board meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by President Yokley. Clerk: Karen Winger
Trustees Present: Tierney, Gettleman, Carter, McMillan, Bunger, Esker

COMMUNICATIONS: President Yokley stated that if any Trustees would like to attend the IML Conference in Chicago they can.

Trustee Tierney made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on July 22, 2024.
Trustee McMillan seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

FINANCE (Tierney): Trustee Tierney made a motion to pay monthly bills. Trustee Bunger seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

PUBLIC SAFETY (Sharon McMillan): Trustee McMillan had nothing new to report.

President Yokley & Chief Edwards encourage residents to ask solicitors to see their permit. They encourage residents to call the Village Hall or Police Department to verify if someone has a valid permit.

WATER & SEWER (Matt Bunger): Trustee Bunger stated we have received a water rate increase notice from CWLP. The current rate is \$4.57/per 100 cubic feet. The new rate is \$4.84/per 100 cubic feet. This is an approximate 6% increase.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (Esker): Trustee Esker had nothing new to report.

PARKS & RECREATION (Dave Carter): Trustee stated a huge crowd attended the JFL games this past weekend. He stated Healthy Kids Run will be starting again in September.

President Yokley stated Kent Thompson is looking into estimates to replace the lights at the park. He said they are beyond repair.

STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS & STORM SEWERS (Patrick Gettleman): Mike and Tammy Steiner attended the meeting to discuss their dumpster in their alley. They had also emailed Trustee Gettleman regarding the issue.

ADDITIONAL BUSINESS: President Yokley asked Randy Segatto to create an ordinance regarding grocery tax. Randy stated this ordinance will need to be passed by October 1st.

Trustee Esker made a motion to appoint Mark Conkrite to the Zoning Board of Appeals. Trustee Carter seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

Trustee Carter introduced an ordinance amending Chapter 173 Section 173.14 customer responsibilities paragraph (A) of the Code. Discussion was made regarding this. President Yokley stated he would like to meet with Public Works first, but possibly might look at other options regarding the weight limit in the alleys.

Trustee Esker made a motion to approve Trick-or-Treat hours from 5-8:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 31st. Trustee McMillan seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

The regular board meeting of the Board of Trustees for the Village of Williamsville adjourned at 6:24 p.m.
