Trustee Brennan made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on June 14, 2021. Trustee Hofferkamp seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

FINANCE (Tierney): Trustee Tierney made a motion to pay bills as presented. Trustee Bunger seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

PUBLIC SAFETY (John Brennan): Trustee Brennan stated he has looked at the Village's animal ordinances. He will be contacting legal counsel. He will be looking into the proper restraints needed for menacing dogs.

WATER & SEWER (Matt Bunger): Trustee Bunger stated the bids were opened for the sewer plant project. He stated the bids were more than we initially approved for the project. He stated the board will be postponing approval of the bid at this time. He stated they will be looking into some change orders for pump size, etc. for this project.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (Hofferkamp): Trustee Hofferkamp gave an update about the Community Center project. She stated there may be possible litigation regarding the Community Center project.

Trustee Hofferkamp stated she has received a complaint from a resident regarding her neighbor's bushes and some drywall that is in the alley.

PARKS & RECREATION (Dave Carter): Trustee Carter stated the baseball program was a success this year. He thanked Public Works for their hard work at the park and around the town. He also stated the Healthy Kids Run was a success. He mentioned that JFL will be starting soon. He stated that JFL is always looking for volunteers and donations.

STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS & STORM SEWERS (Patrick Gettleman): Trustee Gettleman had nothing new to report.

ADDITIONAL BUSINESS: President Yokley thanked all Village employees for their hard work. He said the employees do an extremely good job and the Village has great employees.

Roy Pyers stated the Interurban Merchant will be having an event on July 25th in celebration of their one-year anniversary. He said they have music planned for the event, and also some vendors who will be set up in the street.
