

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR
THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSVILLE
March 22, 2021**

The Town Hall/board meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by President Yokley. Clerk: Karen Winger.
Trustees Present or via telephone: Gettleman, Carter, Bunger, Brennan, Hofferkamp, Tierney.

COMMUNICATIONS: No communications to report.

Trustee Hofferkamp made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on March 8, 2021. Trustee Brennan seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

FINANCE (Tierney): Trustee Tierney made a motion to pay bills as presented. Trustee Gettleman seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

PUBLIC SAFETY (John Brennan): Trustee Brennan had nothing new to report.

WATER & SEWER (Matt Bunger): Trustee Bunger had nothing new to report.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (Hofferkamp): Trustee Hofferkamp shared an update on the Community Center project. She stated the brick work has been completed. There will be a water-based stain put on the bricks (in approximately 30 days once the bricks have a chance to cure) so the color will match the existing brick. She stated we will be having handicap accessible doors installed on both ends of the wall of the Community Center. Once the doors have been installed, we will be having handicap door openers installed on the doors. These openers were not in the original bid, so there will be an additional cost for these. This may cost up to an additional \$5,000, since the doors were not in the original bid due to originally not planning to replace the doors.

Trustee Hofferkamp has scheduled a committee meeting for April 12th to discuss the Community Center project.

PARKS & RECREATION (Dave Carter): Trustee Carter reminded everyone about "Picnic in the Park" scheduled for May 16th. This is a fundraiser for the park.

Trustee Carter thanked the coal mine for their plan to buy the food/drinks for the event. He also stated they would like to work with the JFL and schedule an event since they lost a season. Trustee Carter thanked the Community Foundation for all their work.

STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS & STORM SEWERS (Patrick Gettleman): Trustee Gettleman had nothing new to report.

ADDITIONAL BUSINESS: No additional business to report.
