

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR
THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSVILLE
May 24, 2021**

The Town Hall/board meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by President Yokley. Clerk: Karen Winger.
Trustees Present or via telephone: Gettleman, Carter, Bunger, Brennan, Hofferkamp, Tierney.

COMMUNICATIONS: President Yokley stated some tree removal/trimming will be taking place in the Village this week. There is also a diseased tree in front of Trustee Hofferkamp's house that will be removed, which is owned by the Village. President Yokley swore in Karen Winger, Village Clerk. Oath was taken.

Trustee Carter made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on May 10, 2021. Trustee Hofferkamp seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

FINANCE (Tierney): Trustee Tierney made a motion to pay bills as presented. Trustee Hofferkamp seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

PUBLIC SAFETY (John Brennan): Trustee Brennan stated a committee meeting was held to discuss the feral cat problem in the Village and some other nuisances. He stated they will draft up some changes to some ordinances for legal counsel to review.

WATER & SEWER (Matt Bunger): President Yokley stated the sewer plant project is supposed to go out for bid this week. President Yokley stated he believes the bids are due before the second board meeting in June, for approval.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (Hofferkamp): Trustee Hofferkamp stated the carpet in the Community Center has been installed. President Yokley stated they still need to install the baseboards in the restrooms. He also stated the shelf is being made by Jim Cousins. It will be made out of oak with a poly finish that will withstand drinks, etc. Our Public Works Department will be placing the stain on the brick of the Community Center. Questions arose regarding the status of our contractor, Ted Contri. President Yokley stated he has received a certified letter.

PARKS & RECREATION (Dave Carter): Trustee Carter thanked the Jr. High for policing the park. He also thanked the Public Works Department for the patching work they have done.

Trustee Carter thanked the Foundation for their hard work on the Picnic in the Park. He said it was greatly appreciated.

STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS & STORM SEWERS (Patrick Gettleman): Trustee Gettleman had nothing new to report. He inquired about the sidewalk that is to be installed on Main Street down to Birch. President Yokley stated there are several areas of sidewalks that need replaced around town also.

ADDITIONAL BUSINESS: President Yokley stated the Village did do the tree replacement to replace the ones we have removed. He stated this will cost approximately \$1,400.00.

Trustee Carter inquired about the Cares Act funds. To this date, we have not received this funding.

The regular board meeting of the Board of Trustees for the Village of Williamsville adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
