**COMMUNICATIONS:**

Trustee Esker made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular Board Meeting held on November 12, 2024. Trustee Bunger seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**FINANCE (Tierney):** Trustee Carter made a motion to pay monthly bills. Trustee McMillan seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

**PUBLIC SAFETY (Sharon McMillan):** Trustee McMillan stated they have received word that there is an issue with the new squad we have ordered. President Yokley suggested we look for a different vehicle. Trustee McMillan stated she will contact Miles Chevrolet.

**WATER & SEWER (Matt Bunger):** President Yokley suggested the Water/Sewer Committee meet to discuss a possible water rate increase due to the increase the Village has received from CWLP. Trustee Bunger will be scheduling a meeting to discuss.

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (Esker):** Trustee Esker had nothing new to report.

**PARKS & RECREATION (Dave Carter):** Trustee Carter thanked Public Works for their hard work with mowing, etc. He also thanked them for decorating the Village.

**STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS & STORM SEWERS (Patrick Gettleman):** Trustee Gettleman made a motion to approve the MFT Resolution (for the winter program) in the amount of \$20,000.00. Trustee Bunger seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

**ADDITIONAL BUSINESS:** President Yokley discussed options for selling the two vacant lots on West Street/Harpole Street. No objections were made regarding advertising for sealed bids when the Village is ready to do so. The Village Board agreed to hiring an appraiser. The Village cannot accept any bids less than eighty percent of the appraised value.

Trustee Gettleman made a motion to approve the hiring of an appraiser. Trustee Esker seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.
