

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR  
THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSVILLE  
October 15, 2024**

The Town Hall/board meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by President Yokley. Clerk: Karen Winger  
Trustees Present: Gettleman, Carter, Esker Absent: Tierney, Bunger, McMillan

**GUESTS:** See attached list. Williamsville Softball team will not be attending the meeting.

**COMMUNICATIONS:** No communications to report.

Trustee Gettleman made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on September 23, 2024.  
Trustee Esker seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**FINANCE (Tierney):** Trustee Esker made a motion to pay monthly bills. Trustee Carter seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

President Yokley introduced the tax levy ordinance. This ordinance will be passed at the next board meeting.

**PUBLIC SAFETY (Sharon McMillan):** Trustee McMillan discussed body cameras and tasers that are needed for the Police Department. She stated we will purchase in 2025; however, if we don't make a commitment now, we will lose a twenty percent discount. Price comparisons were also completed with Senegy. She stated tasers and better software for the body cameras are both needed. After consideration, she stated Axon is the "quote of choice". Chief Edwards stated the upgrade would decrease the number of manhours needed regarding body cam footage. (See attached -Trustee McMillan prepared a price comparison for the Trustees.)

Trustee Gettleman made a motion to approve the estimate from Axon in the amount of \$60,755.30 (paid over five years). Trustee Esker seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

The weather sirens are not currently operating. Discussion regarding the sirens was made by Sergeant Alec Tucker. The Village is considering purchasing a system that is controlled through the National Weather Service in the amount of \$23,763.00. There is an annual fee of \$2,246.00. The National Weather Service or the Fire Department can control the sirens. The Fire Dept. would like to keep two of the devices in the basement. They would like to pay to offset the expense by approximately \$6,000.00.

Trustee Carter made a motion to approve the estimate from Federal Signal in the amount of \$23,763.00. Trustee Gettleman seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

**WATER & SEWER (Matt Bunger):** Trustee Bunger was absent.

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (Esker):** Randy Segatto is still working with Dollar General in regards to annexation.

No objections were made regarding asking the Planning Commission to rezone the two proposed lots by the new lake. The zoning is currently R2. The board would like it to be R1. Planning Commission will be notified of the request.

**PARKS & RECREATION (Dave Carter):** Trustee Carter stated JFL was very successful.

Trustee Carter stated there will be a softball tournament held at the park on October 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>.

The Village would like to ban bicycles and electric scooters from the tennis, pickleball, and basketball courts. Randy Segatto will draft an ordinance.

**STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS & STORM SEWERS (Patrick Gettleman)**: Trustee Gettleman had nothing new to report.

**ADDITIONAL BUSINESS**: Trustee Carter made a motion to approve an estimate from Ace Sign Co. in the amount of \$2,156.75 to replace the historical markers around the Village. They are located at Dave May's building, the Depot, and on the side of Auggie Casson's building. Trustee Esker seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

The regular board meeting of the Board of Trustees for the Village of Williamsville adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
